Directions to Pridhamsleigh Cave meeting point

From A38 Westbound From Exeter

- From M5 / Exeter Continue forward onto the A38 (signposted Torquay, Plymouth)
- Take right hand lanes to keep on the A38 and ascend onto The Devon Expressway (signposted Plymouth)
- After approximately 16 miles At the first junction signposted Buckfastleigh, Buckfast (Dart Bridge junction with A384) branch left, then at the T-junction turn right towards Buckfastleigh.
- Cross over bridge past first junction back onto A38 eastbound.
- After a very short distance take turning to the right B3380 towards Ashburton (if you get to the mini roundabout you have gone too far, turn around and take take first left)
- Go past the hotel / pub on the right, over the brow of the hill, at the bottom of the following depression in the road take small lane to the right, signposted Pridhamsleigh (this lane can be hard to spot if your approaching at speed)
- Continue down narrow lane.
- Please park in small layby on right hand side of road before crossing the bridge over the A38

From A38 Eastbound From Plymouth

- From Marsh Mills Roundabout Plymouth, continue forward on the A38 (signposted Exeter)
- After approximately 17 miles ignore first junction signposted Buckfastleigh
- At the next junction signposted Buckfastleigh, Buckfast (Dart Bridge junction with A384) branch left, then at the T-junction turn left towards Buckfastleigh.
- After a very short distance take turning to the right B3380 towards Ashburton (if you get to the mini roundabout you have gone too far, turn around and take take first left)
- Go past the hotel / pub on the right, over the brow of the hill, at the bottom of the following depression in the road take small lane to the right, signposted Pridhamsleigh (this lane can be hard to spot if your approaching at speed)
- Continue down narrow lane.
- Please park in small layby on right hand side of road before crossing the bridge over the A38
